## New This Release

---

- 8.0.96.0 Added an option that omits onsite items from the commissary on resident kiosks**  
*There is a new option in User Options > Inventory called 'Send Onsite Products to Kiosk'. The setting is True by default and will behave as normal. If the setting is False, any item that is set to Onsite will not get sent to the kiosk for ordering. This change also impacts phone ordering.*

## Enhancements

---

- 7.0.1112.21 Fixed Camera Integration For Pictures Taken At An Interval**  
*The camera on an atm can now take pictures at an interval specified in the options. ATM 7.0.1112.21*
- 8.0.104.0 Manual Entry Now Shows In Comment For Non-Kiosk Entries**  
*If money is added to an account manually instead of through the actual booking kiosk, it will now display "Manual Entry -" at the beginning of the comment.*
- 8.0.106.0 Debit PIN Responsibility Agreement**  
*This adds an option in the phone tab to either show or hide the Debit PIN Responsibility Agreement on the Phone PIN reports.*
- 8.0.88.0 Fixed Issue With Site Address Disappearing**  
*There was an issue that could cause the site address to disappear. This issue has been addressed.*

- 8.0.92.0 Added External Site ID to the ICS Webservice interface**  
*The ICS Webservice interface can now send an External Site ID so ICS can differentiate between multiple campuses at the same facility structure.*
- 8.0.94.0 Added An Option To Hide The Dates On Scheduled Payments**  
*Added an option in the entry tab to hide the dates of Scheduled Payments. If the option is checked, it will not show the date for the Scheduled Payment. If unchecked, it will leave the date in the comment.*
- 8.0.99.0 Day limit for Manual Restrictions now go up to 999**  
*The maximum number of days an inmate can now manually be put on a restriction is now 999.*
- WEB Driver License Numbers Are Now Forced Uppercase**  
*All driver license numbers are now forced uppercase. Family members and officers can no longer enter them in as lower case.*

- 8.0.103.0 Fixed Debit Disbursement Showing For The Wrong Users**  
*This update will hide the debit option in the disbursement options when releasing an inmate if the user does not have permissions for debit cards.*
- 8.0.97.0 Fixed AccountCache issue**  
*Networking issues could cause an error during order posting that would cause inmate balances to need to be rebuilt from the transaction journal.*
- 8.0.98.0 Fixed Increasing Delays When Using Legacy Phone Time**  
*Fixed an issue with the Legacy Phone Time interface that would make each release take longer than the last.*
- WEB Require PREA video option should correctly save/load**  
*Fixed a problem where the Require PREA video option wouldn't save/load properly.*
- WEB Optimized the charges import on the website**  
*Sped up the import and corrected some database handling for the charges import.*
- WEB Search Scheduled Video Calls Start and End Date Displaying Incorrectly**  
*Fixed an issue where the search was converting the date from UTC instead of to UTC.*
